

PACKING LIST

General: Plan for Alaska Peninsula summer/fall temperatures of 46f to 60f and hope for some not unusual 60f to 75f degree days. Plan for showers and possible Aleutian winds. We will be spending entire days on excursion away from the lodge, by boat or aircraft. Layered clothing is best, with synthetic fabrics. Cotton is a poor choice, absorbs water and difficult to dry. Fleece will be your friend as well as quality rain gear, tops and bottoms.

Outerwear: wind proof/ waterproof jacket with hood and rain pants, as we will be traveling the river in open jet boats. Warm wind proof gloves or mittens, warm hat and knee high rubber boots, for accessing boats in shallow water.

Casual wear: 2 shirts of choice, 1 warm synthetic shirt for day outings. 2 pair comfortable casual pants, 1 pair warm synthetic pants for day outings. 3 pair comfortable socks. Your favorite hat or cap.

Footwear: Knee high rubber boots that fit well for walking. Water resistant hiking boots, athletic shoes for lodge wear. 2 pair Synthetic cold weather socks for under your boots.

Underwear: 1 pair synthetic medium weight insulated underwear, bottoms and tops 3 pair of your normal underwear, avoid cotton is best.

Personal Items: medication, toothbrush and paste, toiletries, insect repellant, insect head net, personal liquor beyond cocktail hour and wine with dinner. We have hair driers, WiFi, shampoo, soap, towels, plenty of hot water and a very comfort bedding and cabins.
